


# ISC Annual Census

The ISC Annual Census was carried out in January 2014. All 1,257 schools in UK membership of the constituent associations completed the survey. The Census covers 511,928 pupils and provides a detailed snapshot of the schools and of the wider social and economic trends in the UK.

## Pupils from overseas

**24,391**

Non-British pupils whose parents live overseas. This figure equates to 4.8% of the total ISC pupil population. In addition, there are a further 11,329 pupils whose parents live in the UK.

## Fee Assistance

**33.4%**

Pupils receive help with their fees. ISC schools provide more than £660m in fee assistance annually.

## Ethnic Diversity

**28.1%**

ISC pupils who are from a Minority Ethnic background.

## Pupil-Teacher Ratio

**9.3**

Pupils for every teacher on average at ISC schools. There is a total number of 54,927 full-time equivalent teachers.

## Higher Education

**92.2%**

Pupils who leave ISC schools and go on to Higher Education. 3.7% of this cohort chose to continue their education beyond the UK.

## Special Educational Needs

**66,579**

The number of pupils at ISC schools who have been identified as having special educational needs.

## Termly Fees

**3.9%**

The lowest annual fee rise since 1994. The overall average termly fee is £4,998 (excluding nursery fees).
