How the Prevent Duty Will be monitored in Higher Education

Roles & Responsibilities



- Here today to tell you about the monitoring regime <u>but</u> HE/FE Co-ordinators are <u>NOT</u> part of the monitoring regime
- HE/FE co-ordinators are there to provide guidance, advice and support
- BIS secretary Of State is responsible for monitoring in HE institutions – the CT&S Act allows the Business Secretary to delegate to an appropriate body

Principles outlined in the Guidance



- The purpose of the duty is to ensure a broadly consistent and common geographical and sector based approach to Prevent.
- The new duty is not intended to create large new burdens on institutions
- The duty is intended to be applied proportionally to risk – so risk assessment and action planning are key

Monitoring Body Operating Principles



- Proportional: Intervention only when necessary.
 Remedies should be appropriate to the risk posed, and costs identified and minimised.
- Accountable: Body should be able to justify decisions and be subject to public scrutiny.
- Consistent: Rules and standards must be joined up and implemented fairly.
- Transparent: Body should be open, and keep regulations simple and user-friendly.
- **Targeted**: Regulation should be focused on the problem and minimise side effects.

Demonstrating Compliance - themes



Awareness and understanding

 of the risk of radicalisation in their area, institution or body

Leadership

- Establish mechanisms for compliance
- Ensure the duty is seen as a priority

Partnership

Productive co-operation will relevant partners

Capability

- To respond to risk
- Appropriate staff trained etc

- Partnership
- Risk Assessment
- Action Planning
- IT policies
- Student Unions and Societies

- Draft Monitoring Framework will be produced
- Opportunity to comment
- Details of process and timescales to be confirmed

 - Commencement date for the duty is set
