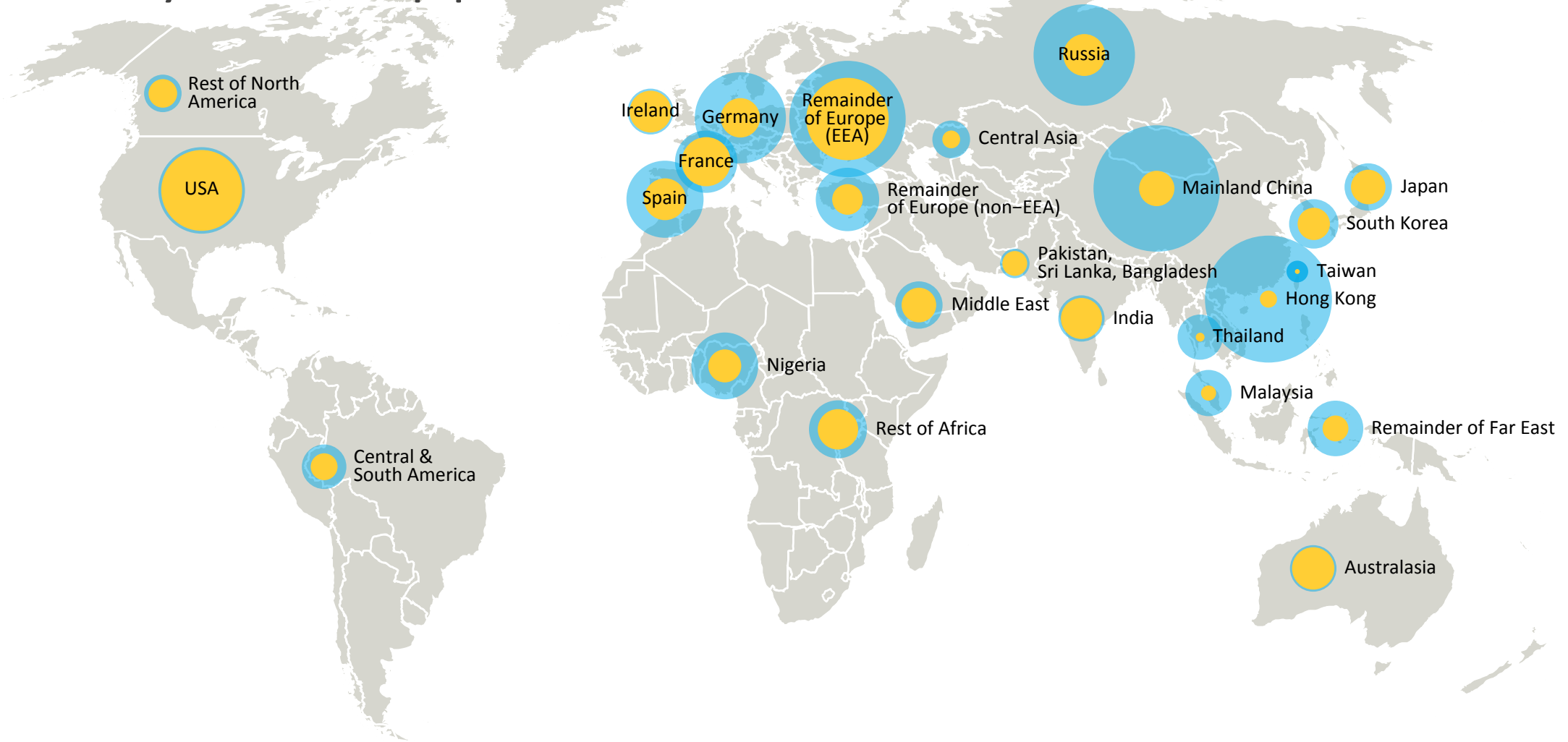


Nationality of non-British pupils at ISC schools

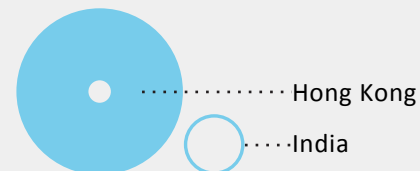

In the 2014 Annual Census, there are two categories of non-British pupils at ISC schools: those whose parents live overseas and those whose parents live in the UK. The 11,329 pupils with parents living in the UK tend to hold passports from different countries than the 24,391 pupils with parents living overseas. For example, 87.3% of the pupils from the USA reside in the UK with their parents, whereas only 1.8% of pupils from Hong Kong do so.
