Statistical Survey of Independent Schools - 1975

These tables contain statistical information derived from a survey carried out by ISIS among members of:-

НМС	-	predominantly boys' schools, whose headmasters are members of the Headmasters' Conference
SHMIS	-	predominantly boys' schools, whose headmasters are members of the Society of Headmasters of Independent Schools
GBGSA	-	girls' schools, whose governing bodies are members of the Association of Governing Bodies of Girls' Public Schools
IAPS	-	predominantly boys' schools, whose headmasters are members of the Incorporated Association of Preparatory Schools
AHMPS	-	girls' schools, whose headmistresses are members of the Association of Head Mistresses of Girls' Preparatory Schools

The survey was taken on 31 January 1975. The information provided relates mainly to the current academic year except that expenditure on buildings covers the financial year ending at varying dates in 1974.

⁽²⁾ The staff ratios for HMC, SHMIS and GBGSA schools are 'weighted' with each sixth-form pupil counted as two. The figures represent the <u>average</u> ratio for each category of school.

⁽³⁾ The overall totals of those three categories are for the <u>secondary</u> level. In addition many of the schools have Junior/Lower departments which are not members of IAPS/AHMPS. The figures are - HMC 10,998 boys, 1,341 girls; SHMIS 331 boys, 46 girls; GBGSA 651 boys, 16,963 girls. Total - 30,330 which makes the GRAND TOTAL as given by the Census 328,028.
