*	GBGSA	-	girls' schools, whose governing bodies are members of the Association of Governing Bodies of Girls' Public Schools only
	IAPS	-	predominantly boys' schools, whose headmasters are members of the Incorporated Association of Preparatory Schools
	AHMPS	-,	girls' schools, whose headmistresses are members of the Association of Head Mistresses of Girls' Preparatory Schools

^{*} When a Head leaves a GSA school, the successor is not automatically elected a member of GSA. Hence a school may be included under GSA one year but under GBGSA the next, and vice versa.

The survey was taken on 31 January 1978. The information provided relates mainly to the current academic year except that expenditure on buildings covers the financial year ending at varying dates in 1977.
