	IAPS	-	predominantly boys' schools, whose headmasters are members of the Incorporated Association of Preparatory Schools
	AHMPS	-	girls' schools, whose headmistresses are members of the Association of Head Mistresses of Girls' Preparatory Schools

<sup>\*</sup> When a Head leaves a GSA school, the successor is not automatically elected a member of GSA. Hence a school may be included under GSA one year but under GBGSA the next, and vice versa.

The survey was taken on 31 January 1980. The information provided relates mainly to the current academic year except that expenditure on buildings covers the financial year ending at varying dates in 1979.

In addition many of the schools have Junior/Lower departments which are not members of IAPS/AHMPS. The figures are HMC 11,610 boys, 2,685 girls; SHMIS 635 boys, 126 girls; GBA 1,192 boys, 511 girls; GSA 523 boys, 16,559 girls; GBGSA 3,516 girls, 214 boys.
