



Statistical Survey of Independent Schools - 1981

These tables contain statistical information derived from a survey carried out by ISIS among members of:-

нмс	 predominantly boys' schools, whose headmasters are members of the Headmasters' Conference
SHMIS	 predominantly boys' schools, whose headmasters are members of the Society of Headmasters of Independent Schools
GBA	 predominantly boys' schools, whose governing bodies are members of the Governing Bodies Association but not of either of the two preceding organisations
GSA	- girls' schools, whose headmistresses are members of the Girls' Schools Association and of the GBGSA
GBGSA	 girls' schools, whose governing bodies are members of the Association of Governing Bodies of Girls' Public Schools only
IAPS	 boys' and girls' schools, whose heads are members of the Incorporated Association of Preparatory Schools
ISAI	boys' and girls' schools, whose heads are members of the Independent Schools Association Incorporated.

The survey was taken in January 1981. The information provided relates mainly to the current academic year except that expenditure on buildings covers the financial year ending at varying dates in 1980.
