Statistical Survey of Independent Schools - January 1982

These tables contain information derived from a survey carried out in January 1982 among members of:-

- HMC - predominantly boys' schools whose heads are members of the Headmasters' Conference
- SHMIS - predominantly boys' schools whose heads are members of the Society of Headmasters of Independent Schools
- GBA - predominantly boys' schools whose governing bodies are members of the Governing Bodies Association but not of HMC or SHMIS
- GSA - girls' schools whose heads are members of the Girls' Schools Association and of the GBGSA
- GBGSA - girls' schools whose governing bodies are members of the Association of Governing Bodies of Girls' Public Schools only
- IAPS - boys' and girls' schools whose heads are members of the Incorporated Association of Preparatory Schools
- ISAI - boys' and girls' schools whose heads are members of the Independent Schools Association Incorporated

The information relates to January 1982, except that expenditure on buildings and equipment is for the financial year ending at various dates in 1981.

INTRODUCTION

The format of this survey of independent schools in membership of National ISIS differs from that of previous years because analysis has been carried out centrally using a computer. It is hoped that the increased amount of information will benefit schools, the media and others who refer to it. Because of the major changes made this year, it has not been possible to give many comparisons with 1981.

Please note that the survey covers just over half the independent schools in Britain which belong to the Associations mentioned opposite. These schools educate about three-quarters of the pupils in independent schools. Figures for all the independent schools in England and Wales, based on Department of Education and Science statistics, may be obtained either from the Department or through ISIS. Figures for Scotland may be obtained from the Scottish Education Department.

Pages 4 - 9 give information for all ISIS schools in groups according to their Associations as listed on page 2. These pages correspond approximately with the lay-out of previous ISIS surveys.

Pages 10 - 31 give more detailed information about each group of schools in turn. Figures in tables are the sums of all the entries made by the schools in each group.

ISIS is the official information centre of the leading independent school associations. It first began compiling statistics on member schools in 1974.
