

Help with Fees at Alleyn's in South London

"Alleyn's is a uniquely energetic, kind and caring school and its message is clear: everyone is welcome"



Alleyn's provides help with fees through means-tested bursaries available at 11+ and 16+, and the School is keen to hear from children who might benefit from an Alleyn's education, but whose circumstances mean that they might not be able to afford the school fees.

10% of Senior School pupils at Alleyn's currently receive means-tested financial assistance, and the average means-tested funding is for over 90% of the fees. For two-thirds of these pupils it means that their families pay no fees at all for them to attend Alleyn's.

The School also provides extra financial assistance as required to make a real difference to children on full bursaries throughout their time at Alleyn's, for example helping with expenses such as school meals, uniform, travel and trips.

Everyone is welcome

"We have an open-door policy here at Alleyn's. Everyone is welcome and we encourage anyone to apply. We want our students to be excited about learning, and we encourage them to pursue their individual interests and passions as well as nurturing social awareness and a curious mind. As such, many of our leavers move on to top university courses and specialist centres of learning such as music, veterinary sciences, the arts and medicine," says interim Head Andy Skinnard.

In the future, the School wants to be able to help even more children to benefit from an Alleyn's education and to feel settled, happy and confident. As such, it is actively fund-raising to expand bursary provision and double the number of pupils that it can help with fees in this way.

Virtual Open Events are now available on the School's website. Applicants for prospective entry in September 2021 simply complete the online registration form on the Alleyn's website before the closing deadline of midday on Friday 6 November for 11+ and midday on Friday 16 October for 16+.

The registration fee is waived for those who qualify for the Pupil Premium at their current school.
