APPLY BY EARLY NOVEMBER OF YEAR 6 OR APPLY BY EARLY DECEMBER OF YEAR 8

Applicants are expected to be of an academic standard that would lead to a Russell Group University admission or show potential in Sport, Art, Music, Drama or some other creative activity for our Performance Scholarships. Scholarship awards are up to the value of 10% of school fees.

For Year 7 awards, applicants should complete a scholarship form by early November in Year 6. Once we have received your form, we will seek references from your current school. We then invite shortlisted candidates to a one-day assessment in late November of Year 6, comprising of tests in Mathematics and English, an IQ test and a group activity. We announce the results in December of Year 6. Potential Sport and Performance Scholars will also be invited for an assessment/audition session.

For Year 9 awards, applicants should complete a scholarship form by early December in Year 8. Once we have received your form, we will seek references from your current school. We then invite shortlisted candidates to a one-day assessment in January of Year 8, comprising of tests in Mathematics and English, an IQ test and a group activity. We announce the results in February of Year 8. Potential Sport, Art and Performance Scholars will also be invited for an assessment/audition session.

AWARDS AT AGE 16 (SIXTH FORM)

APPLY BY MARCH OF YEAR 11

Sixth Form Scholarships, worth up to 10% of the school fees, are awarded for academics, art, performance or sport. Applicants for a Music Scholarship must be Grade 7 or equivalent in at least one instrument. Applicants for a Scholarship in Sport should already be competing at regional level in their chosen area.

Academic applicants will be expected to achieve specified grades at GCSE or equivalent, in order to be successful. The minimum requirement would be 8 grades at A*/A. Academic Scholarships will be awarded based on predicted grades. Applicants for a Music, Art, Performance and Sport Scholarships will be given a practical test at the school.
